John Maxwell said ‘Leadership is not about titles, positions or flowcharts. It is about one life influencing another’. Also Leadership is about mapping out where you need to go to "win" as a team or an organization; and it is dynamic, exciting, and inspiring.

Leadership is an important skill in our life which helps to maximize efficiency and to achieve goals. The following points justify the importance of leadership in a concern:

Initiates action – Motivation -Providing guidance -Creating confidence -Building morale -Builds work environment -Co-ordination.

Transformational Leadership is all about using your actions to elevate others. This can be done with idealized influence, inspirational motivation, individualized consideration and intellectual stimulation. This serves to enhance the motivation, morale, and performance of followers through a variety of mechanisms

Qualities of a Leader have got multidimensional traits in a person who makes their appealing and effective in behavior. The following are the requisites to be present in a good leader: Physical appearance, Vision and foresight, Intelligence, Communicative skills, Knowledge of work, Sense of responsibility, Self-confidence, Humanist, Empathy.
