








India: The scale of things







Healthcare Allocation as a Percentage of GDP






Valuation of Health in Collective Productivity




Total disease burden by cause, India, 1990 to 2017

DALYs measure the total burden of disease – both from years of life lost due to premature death and years lived with a disability. One DALY equals one lost year of healthy life.










Disease burden by age, India, 1990 to 2017




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Disease burden from non-communicable diseases vs. GDP per capita, 2017


