The aim is to reach the 15,000 children. The funds from the Global Grant shall cover the costs for preparing physical infrastructure for medical care, purchasing a well-equipped mobile hospital on wheels to provide outreach services in the villages, vaccinations, running the program, and IT infrastructure to efficiently manage the program and monitor its success. Furthermore, some of the costs for running the program shall also be covered by the Grant.
