Catherine Belzung is currently full Professor in Neuroscience at the University of Tours. She is also a Senior member of the Institute Universitaire de France, a prestigious French Institution. She is currently chairing the iBrain Institute in Tours which is an inter-disciplinary center combining 14 disciplines, from humanities to physics, biology to neuroscience, pharmacology to health and social behavior.

She has devoted her inter-disciplinary work to developing a personalized approach to the understanding and impact of psychiatric disorders. Over nearly two decades she has been conducting intensive scientific research on anxiety, behaviour and depression. Her initial training included the 'Story of Art and Psychology'. She has been awarded several prestigious prizes, the most recent being the Legion d'Honneur from France.
