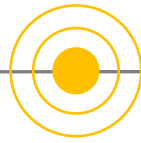

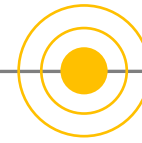

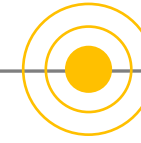

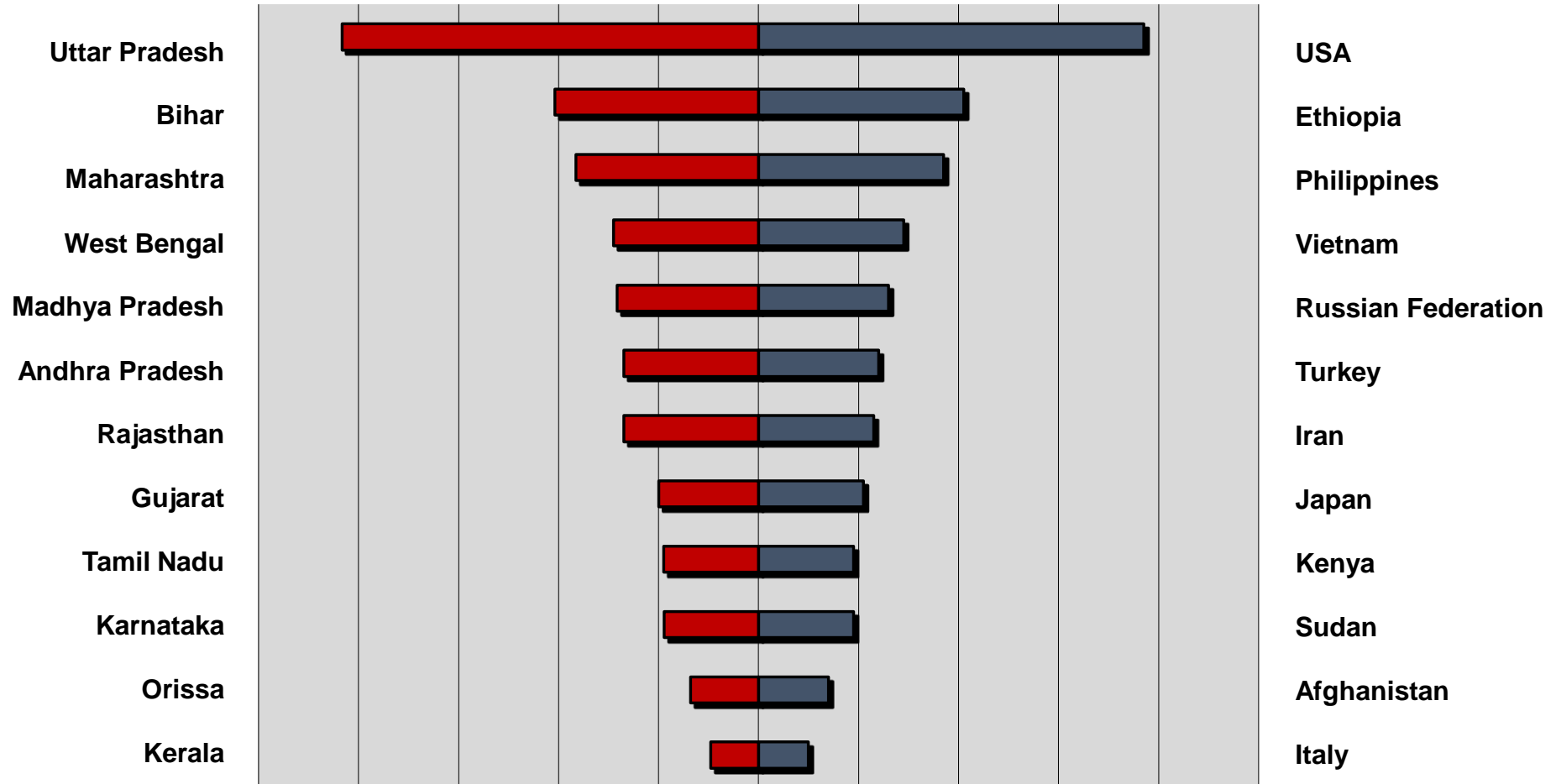


Immunization coverage for 12-23 month olds

Vaccines

- The measles vaccine alone saved an estimated 1.7 crore lives between 2000 and 2015
- Immunisation currently prevents 45-55 lakh deaths every year



Education

- Social determinant of health
- Increased accessibility of public health interventions and challenged social norms against child marriage and teenage pregnancy

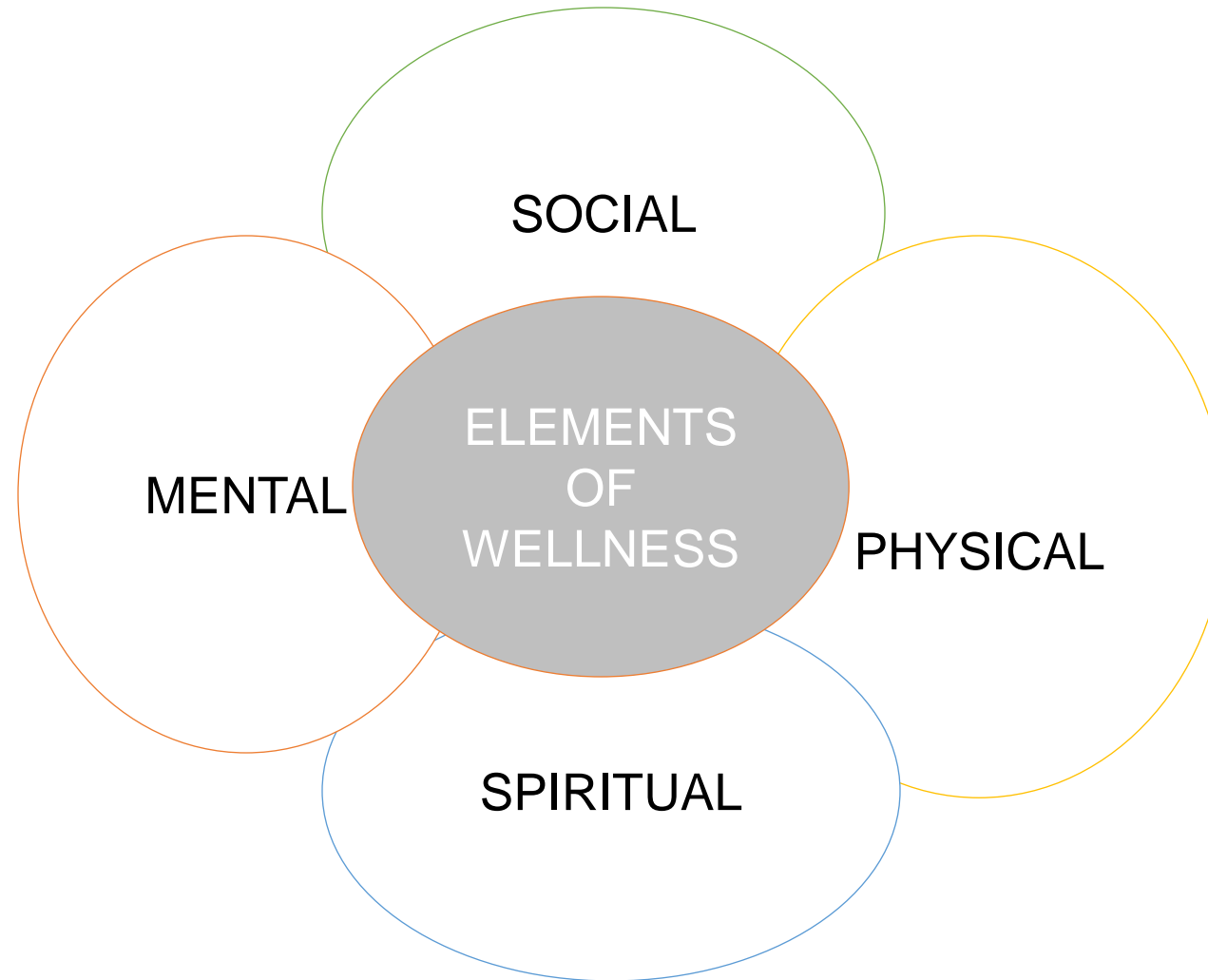

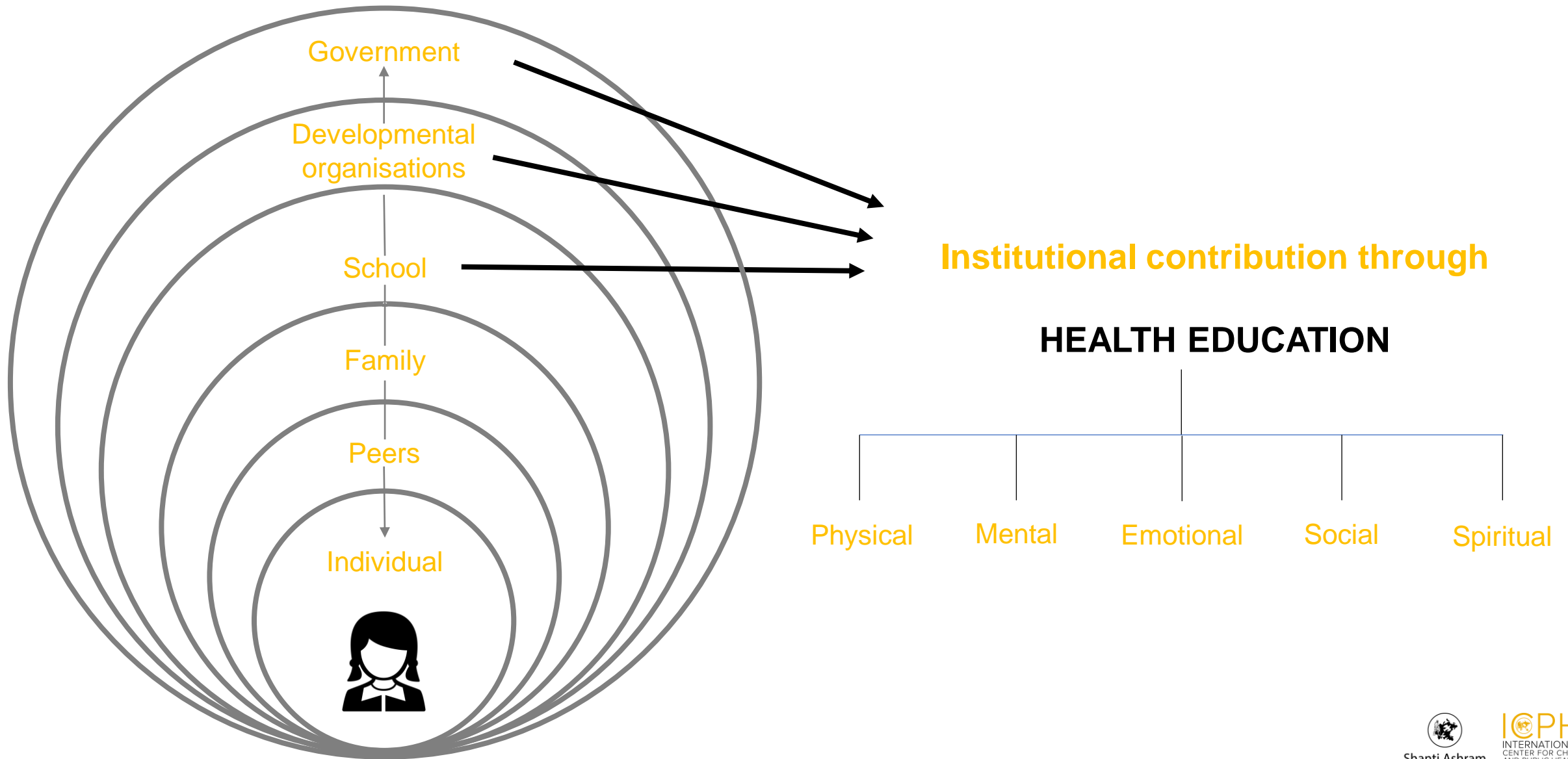
